Scene 3 Part 15 The Gathering of the Wheat into the Barn

They turn around, and one by one, they begin walking towards the open doors of the barn.

They have a different look about them. They are standing very straight, their heads held high, and a look of determination about them. They are no longer in view as they disappear into the barn, exiting off the stage.

The curtains close.

The Book (Bible)

The Book (Bible) explains that the characters with the dirty white robes and wheat tassels are walking towards the barn, they are walking towards their execution. The book further explains that these know that this is the path they must go. They must be strong. They realize that they had grievously sinned against the Lord Jesus Christ and this is their punishment. They accept it willingly knowing that they will receive eternal life with the Lord Jesus Christ.

They remember the words spoken to them by the members of the audience. They will hold their heads high and become the Overcomers. They will have victory over the Beast.

Matthew 13:30 Let both (Serpents and Scorpions who are the tares and the Multitude) grow together (participate in the apostate churches) until the harvest, (The End – their Execution) and at the time of harvest (The End – their Execution) I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares (Serpents and Scorpions) and bind them (The Contract) in bundles (The bundles of the Serpents and Scorpions) to burn them, (In the Lake of Fire) but gather (The execution of the Multitude) the wheat (Multitude) into my barn. (The New Jerusalem)

Luke 3:17 His winnowing fan is in His hand, (*The Tribulation*) and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, (*The Tribulation*) and gather (*The execution of the Multitude*) the wheat (*Multitude*) into His barn; (*The New Jerusalem*) but the chaff (*Serpents and Scorpions*) He will burn with unquenchable fire. (*In the Lake of Fire*)
